Members

This is your club and the fundamental rule of your club is "Consideration for one's fellow members". In heeding the information and advice contained in this syllabus, not only will you gain considerable pleasure from the time you elect to spend on the course and/or in the clubhouse, you will be adding to the pleasure and comfort of your fellow members. "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you".

Members Property

Hidden Valley Golf & Country Club shall not be held liable for any loss of or damage to the property of any member in or on the premises.

Car Parking

In consideration of others, members are requested to strictly observe the marked areas by parking within the marked areas. Members must not use the areas reserved for committee members at any time.

Introduction Of Visitors

Visiting members of other golf clubs with an Australian Handicap may be introduced to the club by a member and play in the daily competition except on days that have "Major Events" scheduled. Visiting members must pay the appropriate green fee and competition fee and indicate their home club on the scorecard.

Members Responsibilities

1. All members must be financial before entering any club competition.
2. Members must know the conditions of play before commencing any round of golf.

3. All members must book their playing time on the sheet provided in the Pro Shop (available up to a fortnight in advance).
4. All members must report to the Tee master (ie the Golf Professional at least fifteen minutes prior to their hit off time.
5. All members must follow directions given by the Tee master in respect to the composition of groups and hit off times.

Members on course responsibilities

1. The player is responsible for knowing the conditions and the rules under which the competition is to be played.
2. The lowest handicapped player in each group is the Captain of the group and is responsible for maintaining etiquette and procedure, including starting and finishing times.
3. Players are requested to pick up as soon as a hole is lost in Par or a point cannot be scored in Stableford.
4. A single player or a group of more than four, except in foursomes, is not a match, and accordingly they have no rights and must give way to all matches of any description and if in competition are liable to disqualification unless permission is obtained from the Match Committee or Tee Master before hand.
5. Players are not to retrieve golf balls from the hole by the use of the head of the putter. Use of the clubhead in this way will cause unnecessary wear and tear to the holes edge and inconvenience the following members.
6. Members please note the local and temporary local rules and penalties posted on notice boards in the clubhouse and pro-shop.
7. Players may visit the spike bar for refreshments after completing the 9th hole but will lose their position on

the 10th tee if the players ahead are out of range and the players following are ready to use the tee.

8. Complaints: All complaints shall be made in writing to the Captain who will forward them to the Match Committee for resolution. Verbal complaints to any members of the Match Committee are not permitted. However questions or disagreements on the rules of golf or the conditions of the competition should be discussed with any member of the Match Committee present on any given day, preferably within 1/2 hour of the completion of play.

No member shall directly reprimand any employee of Hidden Valley Golf and Country Club.

Guest Days

The Match Committee may introduce these events on Public Holidays. Members may invite any handicap player to attend and play off his/her official handicap. A normal competition entry fee shall be paid for the guest. Members are responsible for signing in the guest and for his/her behaviour on course and in the clubhouse.

Dress Regulations

Members are reminded that they and their guests should be correctly attired in the Club House and on the course at all times. The minimum requirement for the dress of members and visitors is that their attire be neat and tidy i.e. shirts with collars, slacks or tailored walk shorts of reasonable length. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Short white sport socks may be worn. In terms of dress code members must set an example.

The following are not acceptable:

- Tracksuits and track suit tops.
- Tee shirts and shirts with slogans.
- Thongs, moccasins, ripple sole shoes.
- Elastic waisted or string tied long trousers and/or shorts.
- It is the responsibility of each member to ensure that they and their guest observe the club's dress rules.
- Jeans

Club House

Members and their guests must observe dress requirements and orderly conduct within the Club House, according to rules laid down by the Management.

Bar

Children under the age of 18 years may be admitted to the Club House in the company of an adult. An adult must make any bar purchase.

Proof of age must be able to be produced if required. Junior members under the age of 18 years are permitted in the bar area, but may not purchase any alcoholic liquor.

Etiquette

- Players should at all times play without delay.
- Players should refrain from throwing clubs and using inappropriate language at all times play.
- No one shall move, talk or stand close to, or directly behind a ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
- The player that is ready shall have the honour when the group in front is clear and it is safe to play.
- No player shall play until the players in front are out of range.
- Players searching for a ball should allow other players coming up to pass them; they should signal to players following them to pass and should not continue until those players are out of range.
- Before leaving a bunker, a player should carefully repair any marks made by him/her and replace the rake in the bunker.
- Through the green a player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced by him/her is replaced at once, pressed down and/or filled.
- Players should ensure that when placing the flagstick no damage is done to the putting green and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing close to the hole, or while handling the flagstick. The flagstick should be replaced properly in the hole before the players leave the putting green.
- When the play of a hole has been completed, players should leave the putting green immediately and mark their cards at the next tee. A player who has incurred a penalty should indicate the fact to his opponent or marker as soon as possible.
- Breaches of etiquette could result in the player in question needing to front the match committee to explain the breach, which may subsequently result in

suspension from the use of the clubs facilities for a determined period of time.

.All players should enter from and exit to the back of the green, ensuring their carts or buggies are positioned behind the green prior to entry. Upon completion of the hole all must immediately exit via the back of the green and depart the area without delay so as not to hold up play.

Club competitions

Subscriptions

Members must be financial before entering any club competition. Members who are in arrears in respect to the payment of fees or other duties, may be deprived of membership privileges, withdrawal of handicaps, etc., pending adjustment of their financial status.

Entry to club competitions

1. Financial members with a current handicap may enter any appropriate competition scheduled by the club provided the competition fee is paid before play commences.
2. Players are required to enter their names on the time sheet provided in the Pro Shop and to report 15 minutes prior to their chosen hit off time. If a player is not able to arrive on time they must ring the club and cancel their bookings as early as possible. This common courtesy will allow members to have full groups. Penalties will be applied to those who fail to cancel.
3. On all days the Professional or his representative is the Tee Master and his/their instructions are to be followed by all members at all times. Players shall start at their nominated time or in major events, the

time laid down by the Match Committee. Failure to be on the tee at the nominated time shall incur a penalty of two strokes in Stroke Play or loss of the first hole in match play or disqualification in serious breaches. (Rule 6.3)

4. The following handicap grades apply for more than 60 players.

A Grade Scratch - 9	Less than 60 players
B Grade 10 - 19	A Grade Scratch - 13
C Grade 20 and above	B Grade 14 and above
 5. At the completion of the round members must place their signed scorecard in the Pro Shop.
 6. Cards not signed by both player and marker and lodged within 30 minutes of completing the round render the competitor liable to disqualification. The current handicap of player must be recorded on the scorecard.
 7. A protest in connection with any competition or match shall be made in writing immediately to the captain, or as a member of the match committee. (Verbal protests are not acceptable). Such protests shall be dealt with as soon as possible by the match committee whose decisions shall be final.
- Players should at all times play without delay.

Tee Off

Play at all times must commence from the first tee, unless otherwise instructed. On a day when the competition under the control of the Match Committee is in progress, a member not taking part may only play where directed by the Tee Master.

The Tee Master has sole discretion as to the order of play and may make adjustment to the event starter sheets if required to do so.

Local Rules

See scorecard and notice boards inside the Club House and outside the Pro Shop.

Use of motorised golf carts

Users are requested not to drive these vehicles within 10 metres of any green or bunker unless there is no other way of getting to the next tee. Lines are marked around all greens in order to designate the areas of distance to be kept when driving a cart

- carts are to be driven on the fairways, while not being driven on designated paths.
- Competitors may use motorized golf carts during all events excluding the Club Championships, except where a medical certificate is lodged with the Match Committee.

Any users of these vehicles seen not to comply with the above basic rules may be asked to leave the course.

Ties

In all 18 Hole events where a tie occurs it shall be resolved using a count back by the Match Committee, except in the monthly medals, medal of medallists, match play competitions, club championships, Foursome and Mixed Foursomes events. (see respective wording under each event further in this syllabus).

Practice

The use of more than one ball during a practice round is not permitted.

Competition winnings

Prizemoney for daily competitions is allocated to each category (eg: winner; runner-up, etc...) and allocated to a prize list that is kept within the pro-shop outlining the aggregate amounts of winnings for each person on that list. These funds are able to be redeemed for purchases of goods or services within the pro-shop.

Jackpot Pin

Nearest the pin on the 9th hole for 1 full week at a time from Monday to Sunday.

OPEN TO FINANCIAL MEMBERS ONLY

AVAILABLE ALL COMPETITION DAYS

ENTRY FEE \$1

To become eligible, the player must enter their name on the sheet in the pro shop and pay the entry fee prior to play.

The funds collected are allocated to the winner to be redeemed via purchases in the pro-shop.

Major Events

Mens Club Championship, Ladies Club Championship, Medal of Medalists, Open Single Match Play Knockout,; Hidden Valley Shield. These major events and a variety of other trophy events, held each year, are listed below

Mens Club Championship

Restricted to 7 day members & lease members who have held their membership for more than 12 months and the following rules and regulations apply.

1. A member must not be deemed to be in arrears with fees or levies due to the club.
2. In all grades a member must have returned at least six single entry competition cards at Hidden Valley during the twelve months immediately preceding the championship.
3. The following grades will apply:
A Grade 0-9 B Grade 10-18 C Grade 19-27
4. The Grade that a player competes in will be determined by their handicap on the first day of the club championships. On all other days members shall play off their handicaps of the day.
5. The final entry fee must be paid prior to Tee-off in the first round.
6. The championship will be determined over 72 holes of gross stroke play, after 36 holes the leading players (number of players will be determined by the match committee) in each grade will be seeded to play together.
7. There will be a concurrent nett competition played over the 72 holes, determined by the overall nett aggregate score in each grade.
8. Any competitor using a motorised cart during this event, except where a current medical certificate is lodged with the Match Committee will be disqualified.

Ladies Club Championship

Restricted to 7 & 6 day members & lease members who have held their membership for more than 12 months and the following rules and regulations apply.

1. A member must not be deemed to be in arrears with fees or levies due to the club.
2. In all grades a member must have returned at least six single entry competition cards at Hidden Valley during the twelve months immediately preceding the championship.
3. One grade will apply
Grade 0-45
4. The Grade that a player competes in will be determined by their handicap on the first day of the club championships. On all other days members shall play off their handicaps of the day.
5. The final entry fee must be paid prior to Tee-off in the first round.
6. The championship will be determined over 54 holes of gross stroke play, after 36 holes the leading players (number of players will be determined by the match committee) will be seeded to play together.
7. There will be a concurrent nett competition played over the 54 holes, determined by the overall nett aggregate score.
8. Any competitor using a motorised cart during this event, except where a current medical certificate is lodged with the Match Committee will be disqualified.

Open Singles Match Play Knock Out (SMPKO)

This event will be open to financial 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf & Country Club only. Match play to be played as stableford, off the white & red tees respectively. Stroke index to be used in these matches.

Eclectic Competition

The event will be open to financial members of Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

To be held in conjunction with Monthly Medal events.

There will be two grades open for this event being "A" grade for players with handicaps of 13 or less and "B" grade for players with handicaps of 14 and above.

A players handicap as at the commencement of their first round of the competition determines their grade for the whole year.

At the conclusion of the first round the players score for each hole is counted as their best score for that hole. That best score continues to count until the player records a lower score on that hole which then replaces the previous score.

The winner in each grade is determined after the final round by tallying the scores for each hole. The winner is the person with the lowest overall score.

There is no requirement to play a minimum number of qualifying rounds. E.g. If only one round is played that is your score.

Prior to the commencement of Round 2 and onwards a Leaders Board will be available on the club's noticeboard for participants to check their progress and position. In addition, sheets showing an individuals hole-by-hole position will be available for viewing prior to each round in the pro shop. Prizes and/or trophies will be awarded to the winner of each grade in this competition.

The Club and Match Committee reserve the right to seek sponsors for the event with attached naming rights. Interested parties should enquire at the Pro Shop.

Monthly Medal Mens

The event will be open to financial 7 day male members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

The maximum handicap is 32.

The winner is the player with the best nett score for the day (all grades).

If there is a tie on the day, the players with the tied score will playoff for the current months medal (eg: April) in the following month (ie May) as well as playing for the monthly medal of that current month (ie: May).

The winner of the previously tied monthly medal will be the person with the best nett score and will be calculated based on the handicap they were playing off when they tied.

Monthly Medal Ladies

The event will be open to financial 7 & 6 day female members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

The maximum handicap is 45.

The winner is the player with the best nett score for the day.

If there is a tie on the day, the players with the tied score will playoff for the current months medal (eg: April) in the following month (ie May) as well as playing for the monthly medal of that current month (ie: May).

The winner of the previously tied monthly medal will be the person with the best nett score and will be calculated based on the handicap they were playing off when they tied.

Medal Of Medalists (separately for Mens and Ladies events)

The event will be open to financial members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only who have won a monthly medal.

The event is to be played off current handicaps as of the date of the event.

The winner is the player with the best nett score for the day.

Players will be grouped together on the designated date of the event and in the event of a tie, a sudden death play-off will occur, commencing from the first hole, approximately 15 minutes from when the last group containing the medal of medallist players have completed their 18 hole medal of medallist event.

Hidden Valley Valley Shield

The event will be open to financial 6 & 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

The event is held over three Sundays as per the syllabus.

This is a stroke event.

The winner is the player with the best aggregate nett score for the 3 rounds (all grades), played off the handicap that they used in the first round of this event.

Ties will be determined by countback.

4BBB Match Play Knock Out (4BBBMPKO)

The event will be open to all financial 6 & 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

Match Play is to be played from the stroke index as Stableford. The team with the best stableford score on the hole wins.

The leading 8 pairs from a 4BBB Stableford qualifying event, progress to a match play knockout.

Draw to be done for all matches.

In the event of a tie after 18 holes, there will be sudden death play off commencing from the first hole.

Mens Foursomes Championship

The event will be open to financial male 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

To be held over 36 holes on a Saturday as per the syllabus.

The winners are the team with the best gross total for the 36 holes.

Foursomes is played by hitting alternate shots.

Player A hits off the odd holes in the first round and then the even holes in the second round.

In the event of a tie there will be a sudden death play off commencing from the first hole.

Mixed Foursomes Championship

The event will be open to financial 6 & 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

Each team must contain a male and a female member.

To be held over 36 holes on a Sunday as per the syllabus.

The winners are the team with the best gross total for the 36 holes.

Foursomes is played by hitting alternate shots.

Player A hits off the odd holes in the first round and then the even holes in the second round.

In the event of a tie there will be a sudden death play off commencing from the first hole.

Summer Challenge

The event will be open to all financial 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

It is to be held over two Saturdays in Summer

The format is Stroke.

The winner is the player with the best aggregate Stroke score over the two rounds.

Final round to be used for countback

Winter Challenge

The event will be open to financial 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

It is to be held over two Saturdays in Winter.

The format is Stableford.

The winner is the player with the best aggregate Stableford score over the two rounds.

Final round to be used for countback

Autumn Challenge

The event will be open to financial 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

It is to be held over two Saturdays in Autumn.

The format is Par.

The winner is the player with the best aggregate Par score over the two rounds.

Final round to be used for countback

Captains Cup Ladies

The event will be open to all lady financial members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

To be held on the last Tuesday of the month (in most instances) or as per the syllabus.

The maximum handicap is 45.

The winner is the player with the best nett score for the day (all grades).

There will be a playoff similar to the medal of medallists for the overall Captains cup Ladies winner, to be played in the month after the final rounds of the Captains Cup Ladies.

Stableford Championship

The event will be open to financial 7 day members of Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

There will be five stableford competition days nominated in the syllabus as Round 1, Round 2 etc. of the Stableford Championship.

The players Stableford score for the day constitutes their score for that completed round.

The champion will be the player who has the highest accumulated points total from their best three completed rounds out of the five designated rounds.

There is no requirement to play a minimum number of qualifying rounds e.g. if only three rounds are played by a player those are the rounds that are counted.

Prior to the commencement of Round 2 onwards a Leaders Board will be available on the club's noticeboard for participants to check their progress and position.

The Club and Match Committee reserve the right to seek sponsors for the event with attached naming rights. Interested parties should enquire at the Pro Shop.

PAR CHAMPIONSHIP

The event will be open to financial 7 day members of Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

There will be five Par competition days nominated in the syllabus as Round 1, Round 2 etc. of the Championship.

The players Par score for the day constitutes their score for that completed round.

The champion will be the player who has the highest accumulated Plus total from their best three completed rounds out of the five designated rounds. For example if a players best three scores are +8, +4, +2 and -3, the accumulated total for the best 3 rounds of these would be +14.

There is no requirement to play a minimum number of qualifying rounds e.g. if only three rounds are played by a player those are the rounds that are counted.

Prior to the commencement of Round 2 onwards a Leaders Board will be available on the club's noticeboard for participants to check their progress and position.

The Club and Match Committee reserve the right to seek sponsors for the event with attached naming rights. Interested parties should enquire at the Pro Shop.

SENIOR TROPHY

The event will be open to financial 6 & 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

This event will be played over 4 rounds with the player with the highest aggregate nett score being the winner. Handicap of the day to be used.

WOMEN'S FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP

The event will be open to financial 6 & 7 day members of the Hidden Valley Golf Club only.

To be held over 36 holes on a Sunday as per the syllabus.

The winners are the team with the best gross total for the 36 holes.

Foursomes is played by hitting alternate shots.

Player A hits off the odd holes in the first round and then the even holes in the second round.

In the event of a tie there will be a sudden death play off commencing from the first hole.
